

## Viewing VC-400 video on the PC and converting to AVI

1. Open the MDVR player
2. Click on the playback tab at the top of the player.
3. At the bottom right click the open to the right of the camera.
4. Under look in select the down arrow and point to your usb drive.
5. Select a .ifv file to play and click open.
6. The file should play.
7. Determine the time period you want to save as an avi file.
8. At the bottom of the player click on the scissors to cut out the clip.
9. When you do this you will see another blue line below the moving tab of the file play. This is your clip line.
10. Right click between the two lines to set a cut point. You will see a little blue marker on the lower blue line.
11. If you want to move the slider to point of time you want to end the cut and the right click again to add the cut point.

12. Then right click and select backup shear avi file.
13. Pick the destination you want to save the file.  
Desktop might be easy to find.
14. Then click OK. It will make the file and tell you it is complete.
15. Now you have the avi file that will play in most players on computers and DVD players.
